



# Mallard-Sweatt Scholarship Application

This scholarship is given in memory of two beloved and dedicated members of Hibben United Methodist Church. For Hibben members only, the scholarship is to help supplement the financial needs of today's students. It is to be awarded on an academic year basis. Only high school seniors are eligible to apply. Completed applications are due to the church office by noon May 6. The application must be in letter style (see item 4 below).

## Eligibility

Applicant must be:

1. An active, full member of Hibben United Methodist Church for at least one full year prior to date of application.
2. A student maintaining a grade level average of "C" or better during the year prior to the award and be able to supply support for grade average.
3. Admitted to a degree program in an accepted college/university and supply the scholarship committee with an acceptance letter.
4. Able to supply the scholarship committee with an introductory letter (considered application) providing information about the applicant. Please provide applicant's full name, address, phone number, college/university attending, future goals and current activities the applicant has participated in at Hibben.
5. At least 17 years of age.

Recipient(s) of this year's scholarship will be announced on Sunday, May 21 during the 10:30 traditional service.

The amount the student(s) receives will be determined by the funds available at the time applications are received. Funding for the scholarship will be provided through the gifts of Hibben members, church offerings, fundraisers and other designated gifts.
