Meal Delivery

The city of Charleston needs volunteers to deliver meals to people without housing during this pandemic. There are two opportunities:

1. Pick up meals to support COVID-19 positive individuals who are homeless and isolated in hotels while they convalesce. Volunteers will pick-up 3 meals from the "horseshoe" driveway in the front of MUSC's main entrance around 8:00am. The meals will then be delivered to a hotel in N. Charleston on N. Rivers Avenue. Volunteers will not have direct interaction with participants but will knock and leave the meals at the door. Volunteers are needed for everyday of the week.
2. Similar to the opportunity above but the recipients are being sheltered in a hotel in downtown Charleston after testing negative for COVID-19. Meals for this group of people will be picked-up from One80 Place with the same method of delivery. Volunteers are needed for everyday of the week.

Due to rising numbers in COVID-19 infections in Charleston County, we will not meet in the Hibben building for worship on July 5. As we have in the past months, we will look two weeks out to the 19th of July for the earliest resumption of in-building worship. In the meantime, we continue with online worship via Facebook and YouTube.

Reopening Announcement

We have missed one another and crave the sight and sound of faces and voices. One of the realities of our community is that large gatherings are difficult in these days as we search for ways to contain and mitigate COVID-19. We do not want to do harm to any individuals of Hibben, any families, any neighbors of our communities or any neighbors of other communities. We recognize in new ways that we are precious not only to God but to one another.

The Leadership Team that consists of Council administrative committee chairs and the ReOpen Team that consists primarily of members of Trustees, pastoral representatives and several at large members; agreed that “to do no harm” at this time was best achieved by continuing to postpone reopening for an additional two weeks and to continue to worship digitally. As it becomes clearer that large gatherings are problematic in the spread of the COVID-19 infections, our focus will adjust to include not only a focus on return to in-building worship on Sunday morning but also smaller gatherings that can allow for connection safely during the entire week.

The Leadership Team will meet again on July 7 to look past July 19. And, please watch for further information as to additional worship opportunities in the month of July. These will be shared by Facebook, Hibben Happenings and other published outlets.

Please continue to remember Hibben UMC in your prayers, to lift-up its members who have struggled with loss from COVID-19 or other illness during these days and the many whose lives are severely curtailed by the restrictions.
