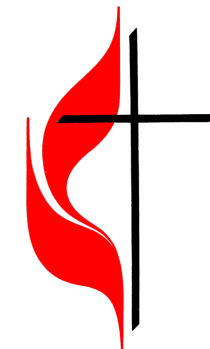
Welcome D.S. Jeffrey Salley
