The Charleston Port and Seafarers' Society is a Christian charity organization, which exists for the purpose of welcoming and serving the needs of men and women who make their livelihood in the port or at sea, without regard for nationality, race, ethnicity, politics, or religion.

Each year the Seafarer volunteers serve over 800 ships, 5000 officers and 15,000 crew members in the ministry centers, and provide at least 1700 transportation trips to help crew members with personal needs.

Hibben supports this ministry each year by packing Christmas care packages that are given to crew members over the Christmas holiday season.
