

SUMMER CAMPS 2025

Summer Camps at Hibben are run by some of our amazing Hibben teachers to help keep the fun and learning going into the summer! Camps are for ages 2-5 and campers are placed into a camp based on the age they are as of the first day of camp. For example, if a camper turns 4 mid-week, they will still enroll in a 2/3 year old camp until the following week. If a child turns 2 during the summer, they are welcome to attend any camps that occur after their 2nd birthday. Camp enrollment will first open to enrolled Hibben families on Monday, Feb 10. Then camp enrollment will open to the public on Monday, Feb 24. We also ask that all 3-year-olds please be <u>fully</u> potty trained before they begin camp.

All children need to wear comfortable clothes that they can easily move in and can get messy and <u>closed</u> <u>toe shoes</u>. Please provide your child with a labeled book bag, labeled water bottle, and a labeled change of clothes in case of an accident. If your 2 year old is in diapers, please make sure they have at least 3 diapers in their bag each day. Children with dietary restrictions may be asked to provide their own snack.

This year, you can pay online via Brightwheel or via cash/check. Please note though, that your spot is not officially reserved until payment is made, so please make payment in Brightwheel ASAP. In the event that we do not have enough campers signed up for a camp to move forward, we will return your fee. If a camp is on a waitlist at the time of your enrollment, you do not need to pay for that camp at that time. You will only pay for that camp if a spot opens for your child.
