A Note from Trustees

The Board of Trustees is committed to being faithful stewards of our church's facilities while carefully managing the resources God has entrusted to us. We know many members have asked why certain maintenance and improvement projects have not yet been completed. The reality is that many of these projects require significant funding, and we must prioritize them as resources become available.

Some of the major projects currently on our list include:

Gym HVAC project (remaining balance):

approximately \$78,000

Replacement of two failed HVAC units:

approximately \$15,000 and \$13,000

Sanctuary AV upgrades (improved speakers and screens):

approximately \$15,000

Campus-wide pressure washing:

approximately \$5,000

Narthex and church office window replacement:

cost to be determined

Parking lot refurbishment and updated signage:

cost to be determined

Sanctuary erosion repair:

cost to be determined

New flooring in the Sanctuary, Chapel, and church offices:

cost to be determined

While these needs are significant, we remain committed to addressing them responsibly and in the order of greatest urgency.

We appreciate your patience, prayers, and continued generosity as we work toward maintaining and improving our campus for current and future generations.
